Personal Financial Disclosure

- Due 12/03/13
- After 12/03/12 - late fees at \$10/day
- After 12/10/13 - late fees, disqualification & removal from ballot

- Continuing (PAC) form by 12/06/13
- Other committees form by 01/05/14

40 Day Before

- Not required

January Quarterly

- Close 12/31/13
- Due 01/15/14

8 Day Before

- Close 01/23/14
- Due 01/27/14

★ 02/04/14 Election Date

30 Day After

- Close 03/01/14
- Due 03/06/14

Successful Candidates: 30 Day After is not required if filing the 40 Day Before April Election Report.

April 8, 2014 Election

Personal Financial Disclosure

- Due 02/04/14
- After 02/04/14 - late fees at \$10/day
- After 02/11/14 - late fees, disqualification & removal from ballot

Committees

- Continuing (PAC) form by 02/07/14
- Other committees form by 03/09/14

40 Day Before

- Close 02/22/14
- Due 02/27/14

8 Day Before

- Close 03/27/14
- Due 03/31/14

April Quarterly

- Close 03/31/14
- Due 04/15/14

★ 04/08/14 Election Date

30 Day After

- Close 05/03/14
- Due 05/09/14

Deadline is next business day due to 05/08/14, falling on a holiday)

ATTN Campaign Committees: For ballot measures to be qualified on the ballot by petition, additional disclosure reports related to the time for filing such petitions must be filed (See [Campaign Committees](#) brochure & [§130.046.2 RSMo.](#) for the law's complete requirements):

- Initial 15 Day Report
- 15 Day After Petition Deadline Report

NOTE: 40 Day Before report only required if accepted contributions or made expenditures for that election.
8 Day Before & 30 Day After reports only required if spent money (made contributions or expenditures) for that election.

Upcoming Filing Deadlines & Reminders

Additional Information

48 Hour Report of Contribution over \$5,000 (File as needed)

- Any individual or committee receiving any contribution (including loans, see §130.011 RSMo. for full definition of contribution) from any single contributor **over \$5,000** must electronically report the contribution to the Missouri Ethics Commission within **48 hours** of its receipt (must also report this contribution in the committee's next filed report).

Late Contribution Report (File as needed)

- Any receipt of a contribution (including loans, see §130.011 RSMo. for full definition of contribution) **over \$250** that is received between the 11th day through the day before the election, must be reported within **24 hours** of its receipt (must also report this contribution in the committee's next filed report). The disclosure may be made electronically or by any written means of communication.

Continuing Committee (PACS) – Late Expenditure Report (File as needed)

- Each time a **continuing committee (PAC)** spends more than **\$250**, whether in a single expenditure or in combined expenditures, after the 12th day before an election, a full disclosure report must be filed within **24 hours**. This does not include contributions made to another committee.

Due Dates & Deadlines for filing:

- **Electronic Filers:**
 - Electronic reports must be filed by 5:00 p.m. on the due date.
- **Paper Filers (Local Campaign Finance & PFD)**
 - Mailed reports must be post-marked, prior to their due date
 - Hand delivered reports must be received by 5:00 p.m. on the due date
- **Weekend/Holiday:**
 - If a due date for filing a report falls on a Saturday, Sunday or an official holiday, it is extended to 5:00 p.m. on the next business day (except for the *48 Hour Report of Contribution over \$5,000*; *Late Contribution Report*; and *Late Expenditure Report*, which are required to be filed within their specific time frames, no extensions).
