

8 Day Before Aug 5, 2014 Primary Election Report

DUE JULY 28, 2014



Review the chart below to determine if your committee is required to file the *8 Day Before Election Report*:

Committee Type	Activity
Campaign Committee	Yes , all campaign committees formed for the Aug 5, 2014 election must e-file this report.
Candidate Committees participating in the Aug 5, 2014 Election	Only required if the candidate committee made expenditures (spent or incurred an expenditure for own candidacy) OR made any contributions to another candidate or committee, since July 1, to support or oppose a candidate or ballot measure on the Aug 5, 2014 election ballot, even if candidate is unopposed.
Candidate Committees NOT participating in the Aug 5, 2014 Election	Only required if the candidate committee made expenditures (spent or incurred an expenditure) OR made any contributions, since July 1, to support or oppose a candidate or ballot measure on the Aug 5, 2014 election ballot, even if candidate is unopposed.
Continuing Committees	Only required if the continuing committee made any contributions or expenditures, since the close of the committee's last report, to support or oppose a candidate or ballot measure on the Aug 5, 2014 election ballot.

If your committee is required to file the 8 Day Before Election Report, include all monies received and spent or incurred (activity) beginning on the day after the closing date of the committee's last previously filed disclosure report **through July 24, 2014**.

To aid in record-keeping and reporting, a full disclosure report is recommended.

E-filers must file no later than 5:00 p.m. on **Monday, July 28, 2014**.

Candidate committees are assessed a **late fee of \$100.00 per day** for the first 8 days and \$10.00 per day thereafter. All other committees are assessed a late fee of **\$10 per day**.
