

April Quarterly Report

Due April 15th, 2013



The April Quarterly disclosure report must list all monies received and spent (activity) beginning on the day after the closing date of **your last previously filed disclosure report** and **closing on March 31, 2013** (do not double report activity by including it on more than one report).

Some committees may have filed reports for the February, March or April election; if so, their April Quarterly may only cover a few days of activity:
