

# JANUARY QUARTERLY REPORT

**DUE JANUARY 15<sup>TH</sup>, 2015**

**The 2015 January Quarterly Report is not a required report. However, for any committee that chooses to file this report, MEC recommends a full disclosure report be filed.** If your committee is a Continuing Committee or Political Party Committee, due to your reporting year ending December 31, 2014, MEC recommends filing a full disclosure report to close out the year.

List **all** monies received and spent or incurred (activity) beginning on the **day after** the closing date of the committee's last previously filed disclosure report (or the date the committee was formed) and closing on December 31, 2014 (**do not double report activity by including it on more than one report**).

No late fees are assessed on the 2015 January Quarterly Report.

If you file a full disclosure report for the 2015 January Quarterly Report, your NEXT report will begin disclosing the committee's activity from January 1, 2015.

#### **Successful candidates in the November 2014 General Election:**

- Since this report will be the first of your new election cycle after the 2014 election, you will revert aggregates for Receipts, Expenditures, and Contributions Made to \$0.00. Money on Hand and Indebtedness will move over from your last report to this report.
- If you haven't amended the Statement of Committee Organization form to reflect your participation in your upcoming election (2016 or 2018), do so immediately.
