The Missouri Ethics Commission, at its April 10, 2007 meeting, took the following actions:

The following cases were dismissed against these Respondents as the allegations were unsubstantiated:

07E010 Matt Mueller, St. Louis, Section 130.041 RSMo.

The Commission accepted a Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order which included a penalty in the amount of \$6,000. However, if Respondent pays \$250 within 45 days of the date of the order, the balance of the penalty will be stayed for 2 years, subject to the following provision: If Respondent has not committed any further violations of the campaign finance laws pursuant to Chapter 130, RSMo 2000, during the 2 year stay then Respondent will not be required to pay the balance of this penalty.

05A082 Irene J. Smith, St. Louis, Section 130.041 RSMo.

The Commission accepted a Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order which included a penalty of \$36,914.00. However, if Respondent pays \$1000 within 45 days of the date of this order, the balance of the penalty will be stayed for 2 years, subject to the following provision: If Respondent has not committed any further violations of the campaign finance laws pursuant to Chapter 130, RSMo 2000, during the 2 year stay then Respondent will not be required to pay the balance of this penalty.
