The Missouri Ethics Commission, at its July 19, 2007 meeting, took the following actions:

An opinion was issued in response to the following:

The Commission accepted a signed Joint Stipulations of Facts and Waiver of Hearing, Conclusions of Law and issued a Consent Order which included an agreement to pay a fee of \$500.00 pursuant to Section 105.961.4(6).

A4191 Wanda Burton, St. Louis, Sections 130.011, 130.041 and 130.046 RSMo.

The Commission accepted a signed Joint Stipulations of Facts and Waiver of Hearing, Conclusions of Law and issued a Consent Order that imposed a penalty in the amount of \$7,000. If respondent pays a fee of \$800 within 8 months after the date of the consent order, the remainder of the penalty will be stayed for two years. If however, Respondent is found to have violated the campaign finance laws pursuant to Chapter 130, RSMo 2000, during the two year stay, Respondent will be required to pay the balance of the penalty as originally imposed by the Commission.

The Commission issued a Consent Order which imposed a penalty in the amount of \$4000 that will be payable in equal monthly installments over a period of six months.
