The Commission accepted a signed Joint Stipulations of Facts and Waiver of Hearing, Conclusions of Law and issued a Consent Order that imposed a penalty in the amount of \$3,000. If respondent pays a fee of \$300 pursuant to Section 105.961.4(6) and 130.072, RSMo, within 45 days after the date of the consent order, the remainder of the penalty will be stayed for two years. If however, Respondent is found to have violated the campaign finance laws pursuant to Chapter

130, RSMo 2000, during the two year stay, Respondent will be required to pay the balance of the penalty as originally imposed by the Commission.

The Commission accepted a signed Joint Stipulations of Facts and Waiver of Hearing, Conclusions of Law and issued a Consent Order that imposed a penalty in the amount of \$3,000. If respondent pays a fee of \$300 pursuant to Section 105.961.4(6) and 130.072, RSMo, within 45 days after the date of the consent order, the remainder of the penalty will be stayed for two years. If however, Respondent is found to have violated the campaign finance laws pursuant to Chapter 130, RSMo 2000, during the two year stay, Respondent will be required to pay the balance of the penalty as originally imposed by the Commission.
