The Commission approved the following Joint Stipulations of facts, waiver of hearing before the Missouri Ethics Commission, and joint proposed Consent Order with findings of fact and conclusions of law:

08A064 Mark Funkhouser and Funkhouser for Kansas City, Section 130.021.2 and 130.021.4(1) RSMo.

Respondent Funkhouser agrees to make payment to the Missouri Ethics Commission in the total amount of \$1,000.00, representing payment of fees pursuant to §105.961.4(6) RSMo. If Respondent Funkhouser fails to pay \$1,000.00 within forty-five (45) days after the date of the Consent Order, or a final determination is made, during a period of two (2) years following the date of the Consent Order, and following exhaustion of any appeals, that Respondents have committed any violations of the campaign finance disclosure laws pursuant to Chapter 130, RSMo 2000, then, in addition to any other remedies available to the Missouri Ethics Commission, Respondent Funkhouser will be immediately liable for the lesser of \$3,400.00, or the difference between \$3,400.00 and any fees paid by Respondent Funkhouser pursuant to this paragraph. Respondents agree that they will comply with all relevant sections of Chapter 130, RSMo. All fees will be paid by check or money order made payable to the Missouri Ethics Commission and sent to the Missouri Ethics Commission.

A4197 Antionette Morgan-Cousins, Sections 130.026.5, 130.041, 130.032.1(3), 130.034 and 130.046 RSMo. The Commission imposed a penalty fee for Count I of \$1,000.00, Count II of \$1,000.00, Count III of \$1,800.00 and Count IV of \$2,000.00 for a total of \$5,800.00. The total fee of \$5,800.00 shall be paid within 45 days of the date of this Order.

The Commission imposed a penalty fee for Count I of \$4,800.00 and Count II of \$2,000.00 for a total of \$6,800.00. The total fee of \$6,800.00 shall be paid within 45 days of the date of this Order.
