The Commission approved the following Joint Stipulations of facts, Waiver of Hearing before the Missouri Ethics Commission, and Joint Proposed Consent Order with Findings of Fact and Conclusion of Law:

10C036 John McGee

The Commission entered a Consent Order with Finding of Fact and Conclusion of Law ("Joint Stipulation") finding probable cause that Respondent John McGee violated §130.031.8, RSMo as stated in the Joint Stipulation. The Commission ordered that a fee is imposed against the Respondent, John McGee, in the amount of \$100.00 pursuant to §105.961.4(6), RSMo. The fee will be paid by check or money order made payable to the Missouri Ethics Commission and sent to the Missouri Ethics Commission, and will be due at the time of execution of this Joint Stipulation.

10E008 Jeffrey Boyd

The Commission entered a Consent Order with Finding of Fact and Conclusion of Law ("Joint Stipulation") finding probable cause that Respondent Jeffrey Boyd violated §130.031.8, RSMo., as stated in the Joint Stipulation. The Commission ordered that a fee is imposed against the Respondent, Jeffrey Boyd, in the amount of \$100.00 pursuant to §105.961.4(6), RSMo. The fee will be paid by check or money order made payable to the Missouri Ethics Commission and sent to the Missouri Ethics Commission, at the time of execution of this Joint Stipulation.

09E293 Citizens to Elect Bill Schuette and Bill Schuette

The Commission entered a Consent Order with Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law (“Joint Stipulation”) finding that Respondents Bill Schuette and Citizens to Elect Bill Schuette violated §130.031.8, RSMo, as stated in the Joint Stipulation. The Commission ordered that a fee is imposed against Respondents Bill Schuette and Citizens to Elect Bill Schuette in the amount of \$100.00 pursuant to §105.961.4(6) RSMo. The fee will be paid by check or money order made payable to the Missouri Ethics Commission and sent to the Missouri Ethics Commission, and will be due at the time of execution of this Joint Stipulation.
