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<b>Email</b> ( <u>REQUIRED</u> - Used to log-in to the lobbyist electronic reporting system and to receive email notices)
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Each lobbyist shall, not later than five days after beginning lobbying activities, file a Lobbyist Registration Statement with the Missouri Ethics Commission (MEC).

**Each Lobbyist Registration Statement must be accompanied by a check or money order made payable to the State of Missouri in the amount of ten dollars (\$10.00).**

After registering with the MEC, each lobbyist will receive a unique ID and password by email. This ID and password will allow the lobbyist to file all Lobbyist Monthly Expenditure Reports electronically with the MEC from this point forward.

Each lobbyist's annual registration shall be effective from the date of registration until December 31st of each year unless personally terminated prior to December 31st.

The time period to renew a currently active lobbyist registration shall be December 1st thru January 5th. If the MEC has not received a renewal registration prior to January 6th, the lobbyist's active status shall be terminated.

Every lobbyist is required to file a Lobbyist Monthly Expenditure Report electronically. This report is due by the 10th of the following month. A late fee of \$10.00 a day is assessed for every day the report is not filed.

Each lobbyist shall also update their principal information electronically within one week of any addition, deletion, or change in the lobbyist's employment or representation.

**Effective August 28, 2016:**

Any person that is a member of the general assembly or holds a statewide office shall not act, serve, or register as a lobbyist until six months after their term of office expires per §105.455, RSMo.

Any person that holds an office requiring appointment by the governor and confirmation by the senate, shall not serve, act, or register as a lobbyist until six months after they leave office.

These provisions apply only to lobbyists employed by a lobbyist principal for pay or other compensation in excess of reimbursement for expenses incurred.

These provisions do not apply to a person acting, serving, or registering as a lobbyist for a state department or agency.

Any person who registers as a lobbyist and also has a candidate committee must dissolve the candidate committee **and** disburse all money of the committee as set forth in §105.465 and §130.097, RSMo.

No person who registers as a lobbyist shall transfer funds from any committee under his or her control to any committee controlled by a candidate or public official per §130.097, RSMo.

***Under penalties of perjury, I declare that I have examined this statement and any accompanying supplements and believe this is a true, correct, and accurate representation of my eligibility and activities as a lobbyist.***
