



Personal Financial Disclosure (PFD) Due

All filers required to file an annual Personal Financial Disclosure (PFD) (§105.483 RSMo), must file by May 1st, 2014, unless you are a candidate in the 2014 August Primary Election, then the due date is April 8th, 2014.

Things to Know:

- The information to be provided in the PFD is for the previous year's activity (2013).
- If you served the entire year in 2013, then your time period covered is January 1st, 2013 through December 31st, 2013.
- If you served only a portion of 2013, then your time period covered is January 1st, 2013 through the last date that you served.
- If you are also a candidate, then your time period covered extends to the closing date of filing for office, so you will report through March 25th, 2014. (E-filers: if candidate position does not display, following instructions in e-filing system to add position).

E-Filing:

1. File by May 1st, 2014, (or April 8th, 2014, if candidate) by 5:00 pm
2. Log-in to [Personal Financial \(PFD\) Filing](#) System (using MEC Online ID & Password sent to you)
3. Enter your information and complete the filing process
4. Retain email confirmation for your records

Paper filing:

1. Hand deliver to MEC office by May 1st, 2014, (or April 8th, 2014, if candidate) by 5:00 pm
2. Mail to MEC (must be postmarked prior to the due date)

Penalties:

1. Late filing fee \$10.00 per day
2. After 30 days, fee increases to \$100 per day (total not to exceed \$6,000)

PFD must be e-filed through MEC e-filing system or filed on paper with original signature, it cannot be emailed or faxed to our office.
