Upcoming Filing Deadlines & Reminders Additional Information

48 Hour Report of Contribution over \$5,000 (File as needed)

•Any individual or committee that receives a single contribution (including a loan, see §130.011 RSMo. for full definition of contribution) from a contributor in an amount **over \$5,000** must electronically report the contribution to the Missouri Ethics Commission within **48 hours** of its receipt (must also report this contribution in the committee's next filed report).

Late Contribution Report (File as needed)

•Any receipt of a contribution (including a loan, see §130.011 RSMo. for full definition of contribution) in an amount **over \$250** that is received between the 11th day through the day before the election, must be reported within **24 hours** of its receipt (must also report this contribution in the committee's next filed report). The disclosure may be made electronically or by any written means of communication.

Continuing Committee (PACS) – Late Expenditure Report (File as needed)

•Each time a **continuing committee (PAC) spends more than \$250** (not including contributions made to another committee), whether in a single expenditure or in combined expenditures, after the 12th day before an election, a full disclosure report must be filed within **24 hours**.

Due Dates & Deadlines for filing:

- Electronic Filers:
 - Electronic reports must be filed by 5:00 p.m. on the due date.
- Paper Filers (Local Campaign Committees, & PFD)
 - Mailed reports must be post-marked, prior to their due date.
 - Hand delivered reports must be received by 5:00 p.m. on the due date.
- Weekend/Holiday:
 - If a due date for filing a report falls on a Saturday, Sunday or an official holiday, it is extended to 5:00 p.m. on the next business day.

(this does not apply to the <u>48 Hour Report of Contribution over \$5,000</u> report or reports required to be filed after the 8 Day Before Election Report (ex: <u>Late Contribution Report</u> and <u>Late Expenditure Report</u> (<u>PACS</u>), which are required to be filed within their specific time frames, no extensions).
