### Mar 2, 2021 St. Louis City Primary Election

#### Personal Financial Disclosure

- Due 1/18/21

#### 40 Day Before Election Report\*

- Close 1/16/21
- Due 1/21/21

#### 8 Day Before\*\*

- Close 2/18/21
- Due 2/22/21

#### 3/2/21 ELECTION DATE

#### 30 Day After\*\*\*

- Close 3/27/21
- Due 4/1/21

#### Successful Candidates:

*30 Day After* is not required for successful candidates moving on to the April General Election.

### April 6, 2021 St. Louis City General Election

#### 40 Day Before\*

- Close 2/20/21
- Due 2/25/21

#### 8 Day Before\*\*

- Close 3/25/21
- Due 03/29/21

#### 4/6/21 ELECTION DATE

#### April Quarterly

- Close 3/31/21
- Due 4/15/21

• **St. Louis City Candidates:** *April Quarterly* is not required for St. Louis City primary candidates that are on the ballot for the April General Municipal Election.

#### 30 Day After\*\*\*

- Close 5/1/21
- Due 5/6/21

*\*40 Day Before* only required if accepted contributions or spent money (made contributions or expenditures (paid or incurred)) for that election.

*\*\*8 Day Before* only required if spent money (made contributions or expenditures (paid or incurred)) for that election.

*\*\*\*30 Day After* only required if: 1) spent money (made contributions or expenditures (paid or incurred)) for that election; or, 2) if debt is more than \$1,000. Successful candidates must file before taking office.

# Upcoming Filing Deadlines & Reminders

## Additional Information

### 48 Hour Report of Contribution over \$5,000 (File as needed)

- Any individual or committee that receives a single contribution (including a loan, see §130.011 RSMo. for full definition of contribution) from a contributor in an amount **over \$5,000** must electronically report the contribution to the Missouri Ethics Commission within **48 hours** of its receipt (must also report this contribution in the committee's next filed report).

### Late Contribution Report (File as needed)

- Any receipt of a contribution (including a loan, see §130.011 RSMo. for full definition of contribution) in an amount **over \$250** that is received between the 11<sup>th</sup> day through the day before the election, must be reported within **24 hours** of its receipt (must also report this contribution in the committee's next filed report). The disclosure may be made electronically or by any written means of communication.

### Continuing Committee (PACS) – Late Expenditure Report (File as needed)

- Each time a **continuing committee (PAC) spends more than \$250**, (not including contributions made to another committee), whether in a single expenditure or in combined expenditures, after the 12<sup>th</sup> day before an election, a full disclosure report must be filed within **24 hours**.

### Due Dates & Deadlines for filing:

- **Electronic Filers:**
  - Electronic reports must be filed by 5:00 p.m. on the due date.
- **Paper Filers (Local Campaign Finance, & PFD)**
  - Mailed reports must be post-marked, prior to their due date.
  - Hand delivered reports must be received by 5:00 p.m. on the due date.
- **Weekend/Holiday:**
  - If a due date for filing a report falls on a Saturday, Sunday or an official holiday, it is extended to 5:00 p.m. on the next business day.  
(this does not apply to the 48 Hour Report of Contribution over \$5,000 report or reports required to be filed after the 8 Day Before Election Report (ex: Late Contribution Report and Late Expenditure Report (PACS), which are required to be filed within their specific time frames, no extensions).
