The Missouri Ethics Commission, at its November 13, 2008 meeting, took the following action:

The following case was dismissed as it was unsubstantiated:

08E116 Eedie Cuminale, St. Louis Co.

The Commission approved the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Orders:

08E123 and 08A147 Steven Webb and Webb 2008, Sections 130.046.1, 130.031.8, 130.041.1 RSMo.

The Commission ordered the Respondent to pay a fee in the amount of \$2,340.00. If Respondent pays \$500.00 of that fee within 45 days after the date of the Order, the remainder of the fee will be stayed for two years. If the Respondent has no further violation of the campaign finance disclosure laws during the two year stay then Respondent will not be required to pay the balance of this fee.

08E054C Warren Leitch, Sections 130.021.5, 130.011, 130.041 and 130.031.8 RSMo.

The Commission ordered the Respondent to pay a fee in the amount of \$500.00. If Respondent pays \$250.00 of that fee within 45 days after the date of the Order, the remainder of the fee will be stayed for two years. If the Respondent has no further violation of the campaign finance disclosure laws during the two year stay then Respondent will not be required to pay the balance of this fee.

07A008 Sandi Colquitt, Sections 130.046.1(2), 130.021.5(6), 130.031.2, 130.041.1(3) (4) RSMo.

The Commission ordered the Respondent to pay a fee in the amount of \$1,600.00. If Respondent has not committed any further violations of the campaign finance disclosure laws during the two year stay then Respondent will not be required to pay a fee.

The Commission approved the following Consent Order:

08R063 Fred Geier and Platte Countians for Tax Relief, Sections 130.021.4(1), 130.021.5, 130.011, 130.011(8) RSMo.

The Commission ordered the Respondent to pay a fee in the amount of \$500.00. If Respondent pays \$100.00 of that fee within 45 days after the date of the Order, the remainder of the fee will be stayed for two years. If the Respondent has no further violation of the campaign finance disclosure laws during the two year stay then Respondent will not be required to pay the balance of this fee.
