The Missouri Ethics Commission, at its August 7, 2009 meeting, took the following actions:

The following cases were dismissed as they were unsubstantiated:

09E104 We Are Crystal, Jefferson Co., Chapter 130, RSMo.

The Commission approved the following Joint Stipulations of Facts, Conclusions of Law, Waiver of Hearing before the Missouri Ethics Commission, and issued a Consent Order in the following cases:

08E083 Phil Elliott

The Commission entered a Consent Order with Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law ("Joint Stipulation") finding probable cause that the Respondent Phil Elliott violated Section 130.031.8 RSMo., as stated in the Joint Stipulation. The Commission ordered that a fee is imposed against the Respondent Phil Elliott in the amount of \$100.00 pursuant to §105.961.4(6) RSMo.

09E071 John Haines

The Commission entered a Consent Order with Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law ("Joint Stipulation") finding probable cause that the Respondent John Haines violated Section 115.646 RSMo., as stated in the Joint Stipulation. The Commission ordered that a letter of reprimand be issued to Respondent John Haines pursuant to §105.961.4(4), RSMo. It is further ordered by the Commission that the appropriate disciplinary authority over Respondent John Haines be notified of this joint stipulation and consent order.

09E087 Joshua Ly

The Commission entered a Consent Order with Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law ("Joint Stipulation") finding probable cause that the Respondent Joshua Ly violated Section 130.031.8 RSMo., as stated in the Joint Stipulation. The Commission ordered that a fee is imposed against the Respondent Joshua Ly in the amount of \$100.00 pursuant to 105.961.4(6) RSMo.

09E084 John Whiddon

The Commission entered a Consent Order with Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law (“Joint Stipulation”) finding probable cause that the Respondent John Whiddon violated Section 130.031.8, RSMo., as stated in the Joint Stipulation. The Commission ordered that a fee be imposed against Respondent John Whiddon in the amount of \$100.00 pursuant to 105.961.4(6) RSMo.

09E099 Janice Robertson

The Commission entered a Consent Order with Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law (“Joint Stipulation”) finding probable cause that the Respondent Janice Robertson violated Section 130.031.8(4) RSMo. and 130.041.1 RSMo., as stated in the Joint Stipulation. The Commission ordered that a fee be imposed against Respondent Janice Robertson in the amount of \$100.00 pursuant to 105.961.4(6).

It is further ordered by the Commission that a fee be imposed against Respondent Janice Robertson in the amount of \$1,000.00 pursuant to 105.961.4(6) for the violation of 130.041.1 RSMo. However, if Respondent pays \$100.00 of that fee within forty-five (45) days after the date of the Order, the remainder of the fee will be stayed for two years on the condition that Respondent Janice Robertson does not commit any further violations of the campaign finance disclosure laws.

09E085 Eric Downs

The Commission entered a Consent Order with Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law (“Joint Stipulation”) finding probable cause that the Respondent Eric Downs violated Section 130.031.8 RSMo., as stated in the Joint Stipulation. The Commission ordered that a fee be imposed against Respondent Eric Downs in the amount of \$100.00 pursuant to 105.961.4(6).
