MEC Candidate Training provides answers to common questions, such as:

Campaign Finance:

- How much cash can I accept from an individual?
- What is an in-kind contribution?
- How much of my own money can I spend?

Personal Financial Disclosure:

- When must I file a personal financial disclosure (PFD)?
- What if I don't file?
- Whose information do I include?

Campaign Materials:

- What must I put on my signs and printed materials?
- What about campaign t-shirts?
